Sexton-Sheehy Show Information

- Entry Deadline – July 5, 2023 (fee and commentary) by 11:59 pm. Late entries will be accepted until July 7th by 12 pm.
- Entry fee- \$20
- Entry fees and entry forms will be submitted through Madison County Fair on FairEntry.com
- Entries close on July 5, 2023
- Commentaries must be turned in to Olivia Rinesmith at orinesmith01@gmail.com or 4290 State Route 142 London, Ohio 43140
- Date: JULY 8th 6:00 pm at the EBY Arena
- This is an open show to any entrant from any county.

Schedule of events

- Check-in is 1 hour long prior to show time (5:00 pm at the EBY Arena) Numbers will be given out during this time.

Classes

- Class 1- Adult 22& Up
- Class 2- Ages 8-10
- Class 3- Ages 11-13
- Class 4- Ages 6-7
- Class 5- Ages 14-16
- Class 6- Pairs Class
- Class 7- Ages 17-21

The individual's age on the day of show will determine the class.

Rules and Regulation

1. Entries in this class must use a lamb sponsored by an exhibitor of a breeding or market sheep at the Madison County Fair. The objective of this class is to present a class of sheep in the most attractive manner, to give spectators in a real opportunity to view a style show, and to improve the image of a sheep show and promote wool.
2. A winning garment of prior years cannot be entered again within the age class.
3. Sheep must be conditioned, any age, fitted, and trained to show on a halter. All rules for exhibiting a sheep at the Madison County Fair pertain.
4. Garments can be made or purchased with a minimum of 50% wool. Entrants must furnish their own garment.
5. If an entrant does not have a sheep, one will be provided by the Lead Line Show. (If exhibitor from another county wishes to participate, they will use a lamb on site if they please. They can bring their own lamb if they so choose.)
6. Judging Standards: (600 points)
 - a. Garment Construction1-100 points
 - Style and/or Fashion and Accessories1-100 points
 - b. Entrant's Poise1-100 points
 - Entrant's Appearance.....1-100 points
 - c. Control of Animal.....1-100 points
 - Presentation of Appearance of Animal.....1-100 points
 - Total Possible.....600 points

*Same Judging Standard will be used for Pairs Class.

*Judges decisions are final and scores will not be shared.

7. Commentaries and entry fee must be turned in by July 2, 2023. Commentaries must include name, phone number, address, email, birthdate, brief biography, description of the garment, awards received, hobbies, and sheep interests. Late fees and commentaries will be accepted. NO REFUNDS.

8. The Pairs Class should demonstrate through fashion what two people can

showcase through versatility and creativity The pairs may consist of two adults one adult and one

child or two children. The person leading the sheep must be able to control the animal. Their outfits should coordinate and relate to each other. The coordinating outfits should be able to be worn to illustrate not only the beauty of wool. but also fashion. The garments must be made of a minimum of 50% wool. No costumes are allowed in the Pairs Class. The same outfit cannot be worn in an individual class and the Pairs class. 9.The person leading the sheep must be able to control the animal.

10. Awards are subject and based on the amount donated per class.

Sponsorships will be available for purchase for a business, farm, 4-H/FFA Clubs, etc. The name will be announced at the show as well as be listed in the program. All funds go directly to the prizes for contestants.
